*A bill to create Guidelines for Establishing Diplomatic Relations Between the Empire and other entities.*

**B**y the Grace of God, Oscar I, Emperor of Karnia and King of Ruthenia, Occidian Emperor and King of Eniarku, King of Bessabia, King of Acrin, King of Horvatia, Szolnók, Geza, Letingia, Escandia, King of Jestia, etc.; Archduke of Karnia, Grand Duke of Gausland, Caledonia; Duke of Ladislavia, Hoheneinsamkeit, Weißeswasser, Csorna, Chedowski, Balaton; Grand Prince of Karcag, Margrave of Luftrein, Duke of Persenburg, Götzödorf, Mohács, Pannonhalm, Podenbrad, Gyalla, Oswiencin, Zallanta, Cieszpreg, Fertodin, Rugoz, Árpád; Princely Count of Bihar, Tamaz, Koberg, Gerizia, Grevenia; Prince of Thomaz-Rocha, Bersód; Margrave of Upper and Lower Lusitia; Count of Heves, Feldkirchenberg, Brevento, Szentes, etc.; Lord of Fürstenbergserdboden, Kazin, etc., etc.

**I**n accordance with the divine and constitutional mandate vested in Us and the August traditions of Our Sovereign lineage, We, Oscar I, Emperor of Karnia and King of Ruthenia, Occidian Emperor, do hereby decree and ordain, through Our supreme and unerring authority, the following edict to be observed and enforced throughout Our dominions:

➤ **Introduction**

Recognizing the importance of fostering peaceful and cooperative relations among micronations, these guidelines aim to provide a framework for the establishment of diplomatic ties. Micronations, though small in scale, have the potential to contribute positively to international cooperation and understanding.

➤ **Section 1 – Recognition and Communication**

1.1. "*Mutual Recognition*": micronations seeking diplomatic relations should first establish mutual recognition of each other's sovereignty and territorial integrity.

1.2. "*Communication channels*": designated representatives or diplomatic channels should be established for effective and formal communication between micronations.

➤ **Section 2 – Protocols**

2.1. "*Accreditation*": each micronation may designate official representatives or ambassadors to serve as points of contact for diplomatic matters.

2.2. "*Diplomatic Immunity*": recognize the concept of diplomatic immunity for accredited representatives, ensuring their protection from legal prosecution within the host micronation.

➤ **Section 3 – Treaties and Agreements Framework**

3.1. "*Bilateral Agreements*": establish a process for negotiating and signing bilateral agreements covering areas such as trade, cultural exchange, environmental cooperation, and more.

3.2. "*Conflict Resolution*": include provisions for diplomatic dialogue and mediation in case of disputes to maintain peaceful relations.

➤ **Section 4 – Cultural Exchange and Cooperation**

4.1. "*Cultural Initiatives*": encourage cultural exchanges, exhibitions, and events to promote understanding and appreciation of each other's unique identities.

4.2. "*Joint Projects*": collaborate on joint projects that could range from scientific research to educational initiatives, aiming to leverage shared interests.

➤ **Section 5 – Economic Relations**

5.1. "*Trade Agreements*": explore the possibility of trade agreements that can benefit both micronations and their respective economies.

5.2. "*Currency Exchange*": if relevant, establish mechanisms for currency exchange or trade in cases where economic cooperation is pursued.

➤ **Section 6 – Humanitarian Cooperation**

**6.1.** “*Assistance during Crises*”: develop mechanisms for providing humanitarian aid or support during times of natural disasters or emergencies.

**6.2.** “*Collaboration in Global Issues*”: coordinate efforts on international issues such as climate change, human rights, and sustainable development.

➤ **Section 7 – Termination of Relations**

**7.1.** “*Diplomatic Break*”: establish procedures for the suspension or termination of diplomatic relations in case of irreconcilable differences or breaches of agreements.

**7.2.** “*Notification*”: ensure that the host micronation is promptly notified of any changes in diplomatic status.

➤ **Section 8 – International Recognition**

**8.1.** “*Multilateral Engagement*”: encourage micronations to engage in multilateral organizations or conferences to strengthen their collective voice and influence.

**8.2.** “*Bilateral Engagement*”: encourage micronations to engage in relations with other micronations and micronational entities.

**8.3.** “*Macronational Recognition*”: seek ways to gain recognition and support from larger, recognized nation-states where possible.

➤ **Section 9 – Requirements for Recognition**

**9.1.** The micronation that offers diplomatic relations to the Empire must:

- a.** exist for at least one year;
- b.** not have drastically change their system of government;
- c.** not have involved in “micronational war” as instrument of foreign policies as prescribed by the Convention of Fruchemburg;
- d.** prove that are activity of the micronation outside online environment;
- e.** not claim Imperial territory, or territory claimed by another micronation recognized by the Empire;
- f.** not disrespect the basics principles of human dignity, as freedom of religion, freedom of speech, equality of gender, equality of ethnicity, etc.

**9.2.** The Empire, for strategical purposes, may recognize micronations that doesn't fulfill the criteria above.

**9.3.** The Empire, for strategical purposes, may revoke recognition, considering the entity as of diverse juridical nature and unfit for diplomatic relations.

➤ **Section 10 – Macronations**

10. The Empire recognize all macronations, pertaining to the United Nations, reserved the recognition of micronations established within those macronations.

➤ **Conclusion**

By adhering to these guidelines, micronations can establish robust and productive diplomatic relations that contribute to global peace, cooperation, and understanding. The establishment of these relations showcases the potential of micronations to positively impact the international community.
